INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT ON FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

To,

Report on the Financial Statements:

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of M/S. CHRISTIAN COMFORTING MINISTRIES, Old No.9A, New No.22, 6th Main Road, Dhandeeswarer nagar, Velachery, Chennai – 600 042 ("the Trust"), which comprise the Balance Sheet as at March 31, 2018 and the Statement of Income and Expenditure for the year then ended and a summary of significant accounting policies.
